This is a very special year for our congregation as 2019 represents the 150th anniversary of our Cathedral parish and its historic involvement in the City of San Diego, both as faith leaders and voice for social justice. To celebrate our anniversary, St. Paul's Episcopal Cathedral will host a celebratory gala on December 13th, 2019, the day closest to the December 18, 1869 official incorporation date.

The Cathedral has always been a vibrant part of San Diego's larger community and we have a shared history with some of the founding leaders of our city, most significantly Alonzo Horton who dedicated the original land of the parish downtown and later the Marston family who helped us with our current location.

Gala 150 will be an historic event unto itself as we will be hosting a black-tie, candlelight catered dinner inside the sanctuary. The pews will be removed for this very special evening that will accommodate 300 of some of San Diego's most influential civic and religious leaders. St. Paul's is honored to have San Diego's first lady, Katherine Stuart Faulconer as our Honorary Chair.

Net proceeds will go to startup costs for the new Cathedral Neighborhood Center that will provide vital services to individuals in our area. This center will continue to fulfill the mission of St. Paul's for years to come.
